Learning to parent a traumatized child is crucial to their healing. Kelly, an experienced therapeutic mom, will give parents an overview of what it means to parent therapeutically and will explore some of the most often used parenting approaches and trainings. In one-hour, parents will not be “taught” therapeutic parenting, but will have a better understanding of what it means and some ideas of where to go to learn more and hone your skills.

Tues., May 3 @ 8:30 pm – Is Therapy Necessary?

But what kind of therapy and how to find the right therapist and treatment approaches can be challenging. Parents will learn how to evaluate and interview to find the right “fit” for their family.

Trauma changes a child's developing brain. Understanding those changes helps parents to understand better what their child needs. Julie will lead us through Brain 101 and what professionals say happens to our children's brains and how that relates to their behaviors. This session will also help to explain why some adjunct therapies are useful for our children.
